At first, / moon-viewing was only done on one day a year, / but it is now so popular / that people will hold moon-viewing parties / several days in a row. // People will have a moon-viewing / even when there is no moon! //
This is called Mugetsu (no moon) / or Ugetsu (rain moon). //

A good moon-viewing party / must have a good view of the moon. //
It will also feature lanterns, / and be decorated with silvergrass. // Tsukimi-dango,/
or white rice dumplings, / are offered to the moon. // They are stacked on a stand /
in the shape of a pyramid. // Naturally, everybody prays / that the moon will protect/
and multiply the harvest. //
